Recording Secretary: There were two corrections to the minutes. The word alleged should be inserted when regarding the letter of complaint that was received by the board at the September meeting.

Treasurers Report: The reports were approved as presented.

League Coordinator: All team fees are current. Captains need to make sure that their name is listed first on the rosters; email addresses should be included also. Score sheets must be filled out in **black ink** so they are readable when faxed into Cheryl. There was a motion for the board to purchase personalized black ink pens for the captains and these will be included in their packets next year. Motion passed.

Division Reps: The letter of complaint received by the board in September was discussed. The appropriate action was decided upon. Players involved will be informed via a letter. There was a motion: Any substantial physical act of aggression will result in that player or players being banned for the remainder of the current season. Motion passed. Each division representative will pass this new resolution onto their team captains. There was a letter concerning default times; captains should refer to the Rules and Regulation on defaults listed on page 7. The issue of 4.5+ players on team rosters below the A level was raised. While City League tennis does not rely on USTA ratings for the placement of players, it has always strongly encouraged higher level City League players to play on their clubs highest available division team. One other letter concerned scoring of a match when one team retires before the end of the match. In this circumstance, the match is "retired" and the retired team retains the points earned; the opponent receives two points. See Rules and Regulations, page 9.)

Old Business: The Tualatin Hills "J" team has accepted the invitation to join the City League for the 2007 roster.

New Business: Sarah Ansboury is the new Green Meadows "H" division rep. Her email address is the same as her mothers. We have no representatives from the Salem area, but an invitation to join the board shall always be offered.
